1. Maintain vigilance while wearing personal protective equipment in order to prevent contamination of your immediate surrounding area
2. According to the CDC, a N95 must be worn during aerosolizing procedures (e.g., intubation/extubation, CPR, open oral suctioning, breathing treatment, bronchoscopy)
