



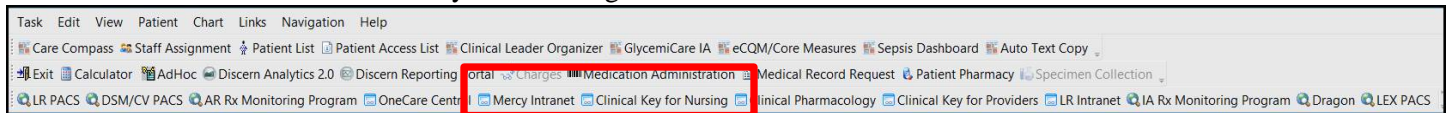

Click on the **Resources** tab.



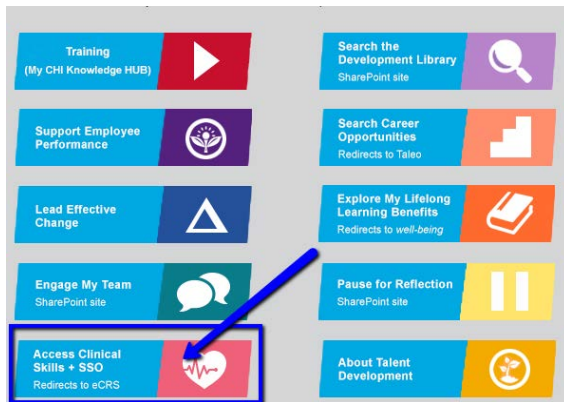

- ii. Clicking the **Clinical Skills SSO** link on the **Learn & Grow** page found under the **Growth** tab on *Inside CHI*.

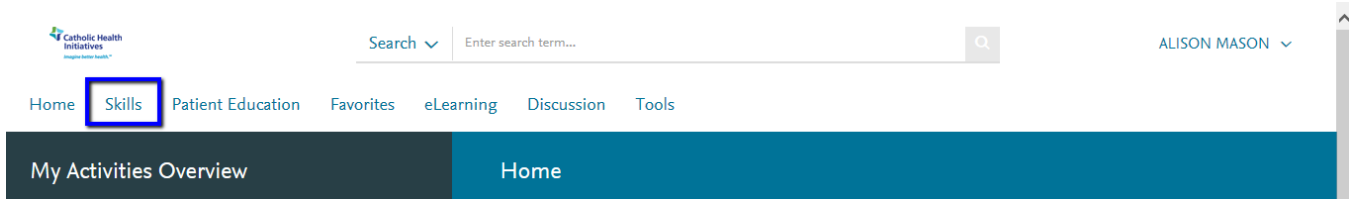

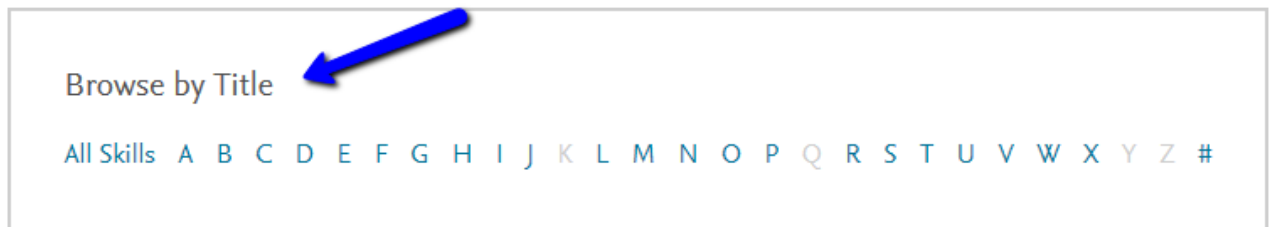
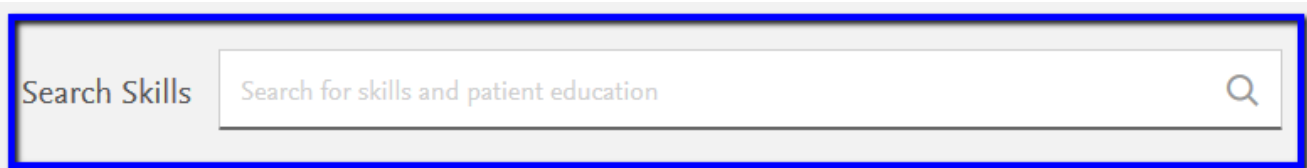


Searching Elsevier Clinical Skills

2. Use the **Search Skills** box to search for a procedure or browse by Title or Specialty.



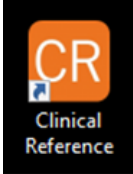

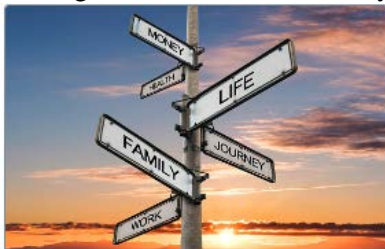
