Health care scholarships up to \$10,000 a year!

The goal of the Humankindness Scholars Program is to attract, educate and retain exceptional health care workers by providing educational scholarships. It also offers networking opportunities with professionals and peers, as well as mentorship from experienced practitioners, to enrich learning and promote academic and career advancement in the competitive health care sector.

### Scholarship Eligibility

To be eligible to receive this scholarship, applicants must:

- Plan to pursue a degree in a health care-related field (e.g., nursing, radiology).
- Have current or pending acceptance to or enrollment in a participating nursing or radiology program; pre-acceptance applications can be submitted.
- Have and maintain a competitive GPA.
- Be willing and eligible to work at a Saint Joseph Health facility for the required commitment period following graduation.



## Humankindness Scholars Program

The Saint Joseph Health Humankindness Scholars Program offers a multitude of benefits to participants, equipping them with specialized knowledge and skills essential for careers in health care. It provides hands-on experience through clinical rotations, internships and research opportunities, allowing students to apply theoretical knowledge in real-world settings as well as facilitating a variety of scholarships to assist with continued education. Participants gain exposure to various medical fields, helping them make informed decisions about their future specializations.

### Three Easy Steps to Apply

#### Step One:

Apply to school/university and get accepted into the participating program\*. Once accepted, complete the scholarship application. **See QR code below.** *The application deadline is three months prior to the start of the semester for which you are applying.*

#### Step Two:

Application will be reviewed by our committee and notification of acceptance will be sent to you prior to the start of the semester.

#### Step Three:

Complete your scholarship year and reapply annually. *(Please review terms and conditions before applying.)*

### Terms and Conditions

1. The employment commitment period for scholarship recipients is one year for each year of scholarship received.  
**Example:** Two years of funding = Two years of post-graduation employment
2. Scholarship recipients must work at one of the following Saint Joseph Health facilities as a full-time (minimum 36 hours per week) bedside RN during the full commitment period:
  - Saint Joseph Hospital – Lexington, KY
  - Saint Joseph East – Lexington, KY
  - Flaget Memorial Hospital – Bardstown, KY
  - Saint Joseph Berea – Berea, KY
  - Saint Joseph London – London, KY
  - Saint Joseph Mount Sterling – Mount Sterling KY
  - Saint Joseph Jessamine – Nicholasville, KY
3. The employment commitment must begin within six months of graduation/licensure.
4. Nurse residency period is not included in commitment requirement.
